About Sigfox

Sigfox is a communications protocol under the emerging area of Low Powered Wide Area Networks (LPWAN). Over the next few years the UK is expected to rapidly expand its LPWAN and Sigfox coverage, giving applications using this technology more widespread feasibility. The technology is expected to be a key driver in a new generation of Internet of Things (IoT) devices which use battery power that can last from months to years.
